

YEMISI A. BOLUMOLE
Biographical Summary

Yemisi A. Bolumole is the Ryder Professor of Supply Chain Management at the Haslam College of Business, University of Tennessee. Prior to this, she was an Associate Professor of Supply Chain Management at the Eli Broad College of Business, Michigan State University and the Director of the Transportation and Logistics Program in the Coggin College of Business at the University of North Florida (UNF). She is a certified solutions architect and consultant for *mySAP ERP*. Dr. Bolumole earned her Bachelor's degree (1992) from University of Lagos, Nigeria, and her MA (Masters in the Arts) in Business and Management (1995) from the University of East London, in the United Kingdom. She received her MSc (Masters in Science) in Energy Conservation and the Environment (1997) and her PhD in Logistics & Supply Chain Management (2001) from Cranfield University in the United Kingdom. Her doctoral thesis, titled "*Logistics Outsourcing in the UK Forecourt Convenience Retail Sector: The Supply Chain Role of Third-Party Service Providers*", was awarded the Director's prize for the best PhD dissertation in 2001.

She is actively involved in grant work, research, and teaching primarily in the areas of strategic logistics, transportation and logistics systems management, global logistics, logistics outsourcing, and the cross-disciplinary areas within supply chain management. Her areas of research emphasis include business-to-government interactions and their supply chain policy implications, third party logistics outsourcing, partnering for optimizing supply chain performance, and the strategic implications of supply chain management. Her research in the policy area has garnered significant national attention, receiving recent visibility during the COVID-19 pandemic through an invited multi-part series of articles published at the *Supply Chain Management Review Business Journal*. To date, her research program has generated over 40 publications, including refereed journal articles in the *Journal of Business Logistics*, *International Journal of Physical Distribution & Logistics Management*, *Transportation Journal*, *International Journal of Logistics Management*, *International Journal of Production Research*, *Journal of Business and Industrial Marketing* and the *Cranfield School of Management Working Paper Series* (peer reviewed), as well as book chapters, numerous professional conference proceedings and other publications.

Dr. Bolumole's significant teaching accomplishments include receiving an Outstanding Teaching Award from the University of North Florida, as well as the AT&T Instructional Technology Award for Best Hybrid/Flipped class at Michigan State University for her adoption of innovative and technology-enabled learning experiences in her courses. She is a frequent participant in MSU's Executive Education Programs and has also taught in several executive education programs for the United States Army, the Ohio State University, the University of North Florida, Northwestern University, and Cranfield School of Management.

Dr. Bolumole has served on more than 40 different committees and other service assignments at UNF, MSU, within the Northeast Florida region, and nationwide, including over 20 leadership positions. She is a regular speaker at sundry professional and academic events. In her current leadership roles, she is the Chair of APICS' *CLTD* certification exam committee and senior editor for the *Journal of Business Logistics*, in addition to being editorial review board member for the *Transportation Journal*, and the *International Journal of Logistics Managements*. She served as advisory panel member for the Jacksonville Transportation Authority/Florida Department of Transportation Regional Transportation Agency Study. Her other service responsibilities include conference track chair, referee, session chair, examiner, presenter, speaker, discussant, education chair, and advisor for various professional organizations such as the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals, the Chartered Institute of Logistics & Transportation, the American Society of Transportation & Logistics, Transportation Clubs International, the Traffic Club of Jacksonville, the Propeller Club of the United States, Port of Jacksonville, and the CSCMP First Coast (Jacksonville) Roundtable.
