### SCOPE OF ASSIGNMENT:

Economic Survey Research Center - Selected students will be cold calling U.S. business leaders to solicit their participation in one of three economic surveys administered by the Atlanta Fed's Economic Survey Research Center. The data collected in these surveys are used to help better inform monetary policymakers on firm's expectations and key concerns. Survey interns will assist with additional survey contact management tasks including outreach to non-responders, researching potential contacts and supporting ad hoc team projects.
