How you finance your degree is a big part of your decision-making process. In addition to these start-up expenses, potential expenses to consider are moving expenses, rent deposit and monthly rent payments, books/laptop, utilities (electricity, gas, and water), etc.

<u>Typical Graduate Assistantships cover tuition and university fees.</u> Students must cover the balance. The Financial Aid Office will only process FAFSA funding for United States Citizens. Additionally, university-wide merit-based scholarships may be obtained through the Graduate School.
