How you finance your degree is a big part of your decision-making process. All admitted applicants are automatically considered for merit-based program-funded assistantships; however, funding is not guaranteed. We recommend that you plan with the full program cost in mind. In addition to these start-up expenses, potential expenses to consider are moving expenses, rent deposit and monthly rent payments, books/laptop, utilities (electricity, gas, and water), etc.

Typical Graduate Assistantships cover tuition and university fees. Students must cover the balance. The Financial Aid Office will only process FAFSA funding for United States Citizens. Additionally, university-wide merit-based scholarships may be obtained through the Graduate School.

¹Seating Deposit is due upon acceptance of admission, is separate from tuition, is not covered by GI bill benefits, and is non-refundable.

²Prep Course costs do not qualify for federal financial aid.

³Winter Mini-Term Global Business Seminar- tuition and fees listed do not cover international travel costs and incidentals (projected cost around \$2,000). Program fee for Mini-Term is a programs abroad fee.
